

Book early for flights, ferries and rooms

Make the most of your visit by planning thoroughly, particularly if you're visiting during our busy summer season. Here are a couple of helpful tips.

Ships of the Alaska Marine Highway call at Ketchikan from mainland ports in Washington state and British Columbia.

- Book transportation well in advance. Seats on Alaska Airlines and Delta, and vehicle spaces on Alaska Marine Highway vessels, fill fast for the peak visitor season, May through September.
- Lock in your lodging early and talk to your host or reservation service about where your lodging is situated in Ketchikan; your host has good advice about options for local transportation.

It's Alaska. Pack for casual comfort and conditions that vary according to the climate and your activities

We're not sticklers about fashion up here. When you're in Ketchikan, do as Ketchikan folks do: match your clothes to your activities. And if we have anything up here, it's activities!

- Pack lightweight shirts you can layer under sweaters and jackets. Light wool and polyester fleece are good choices for outer layers.
- Your comfortable pants are welcome anywhere. On warm days a pair of shorts will feel just right. But be prepared for a maritime climate and a rain forest setting; we recommend you bring a water-resistant coat with a hood and sturdy, waterproof shoes.
- Lightweight gloves and rain gear may be needed for hikes and saltwater excursions. Sunglasses and sunscreen are recommended for our long summer days, especially if you'll be on the water.
- If you're prone to motion sickness, see a physician before your trip.



Getting to Ketchikan

You have options for traveling to Ketchikan. Here's an overview.

- Alaska Airlines provides daily, year-round service from Seattle; flights from other Alaskan cities also land daily. Delta provides daily service from Seattle mid-May through September. alaskaair.com delta.com
- For a sea voyage, book on an Alaska Marine Highway ferry sailing here from Bellingham, Wash., or Prince Rupert, B.C. ferryalaska.com
- Major cruise lines call in this popular port on the Inside Passage.
- Ketchikan offers public and private moorage as well as a host of services for visiting yachts and pleasure boats.
- Space for private aircraft and services such as fuel are available at Ketchikan's airport. www.kgbak.us/130/Airport

From the airport to the city by sea

Ketchikan International Airport on Gravina Island is five minutes by ferry from town.

- Ferries depart from the airport on the hour and half-hour; ferries depart Ketchikan to the airport 15 and 45 minutes after the hour. During peak summer travel times, departures are every 15 minutes. The adult fare is \$6; one-way fare for a standard car is \$7. Cash and credit cards are accepted. Free baggage carts are available.
- Rental cars can be picked up from rental agencies at Ketchikan International Airport or at the agencies' offices in town.

Getting around on the ground in Ketchikan

Taxis meet arriving airport and state ferries. Rates are \$3.70 a drop and \$3.30 per mile. The typical one-way fare to downtown from the airport ferry landing is about \$13; to downtown from the Alaska Marine Highway ferry terminal, about \$12.



Municipal bus service runs daily in the city; routes also reach south and north of town. Service is hourly. Hours are reduced on Sundays.

- The fare is \$1 for adults, \$.50 for children and seniors. A day pass is \$2.
- A free downtown shuttle runs every 20 minutes, May through September.


Public parking lots have time restrictions or require permits. One-day parking permits are \$5 at City Hall on Front Street.

Foot and car traffic is heavy in summer. Observe traffic rules, use crosswalks and follow crossing guards' directions. Don't climb over or through ropes and rails.

Ketchikan offers a wide range of accommodations for relaxation after an exciting day. Select from full-service hotels and motels, vacation rentals, bed and breakfasts, fishing lodges and world-class resorts. Hostels are also available. Rates vary by the season; fall, winter and spring visits offer opportunities for Alaskan adventure at reduced rates. Lodging sites vary from the historic heart of the city to secluded oceanside settings.

Options include plush lodges and homey B&Bs. The sites range from mountain flanks, as seen here, to perches on the ocean shore.

- Most bed and breakfast facilities offer private, apartment-style living.
- In-town and remote fishing lodges and resorts are available. Choose from fully guided resort packages or do-it-yourself options with boats and gear.

Comfortable lodging for every budget category is available in the Ketchikan area. Here's a sampling of price ranges for accommodations.

LODGES AND RESORTS

Moderate – \$375 to \$650 per day. First Class – \$650 and up. Lodging, meals, fishing, processing and transport are usually included.

HOTELS

Moderate – \$125 and up per night in summer season; \$79 and up in fall, winter and spring. First Class – \$220 and up per night in summer season; \$119 and up in fall, winter and spring.

HOSTELS

\$20 and up per night.

B&Bs / VACATION RENTALS

\$115 and up per night in summer; \$75 and up in fall, winter and spring. Monthly rates are available. Minimum stays may be required in peak season.

Camping and RV facilities

Ward Lake Recreation Area has three campgrounds with 47 sites; some sites accommodate vehicles to 45 feet and most handle 30- to 36-footers. Reserve at U.S.F.S.

Settlers Cove Campground has 14 campsites on the ocean about 18 miles north of the city. Thirteen sites accommodate RVs; four handle vehicles to 35 feet. All sites at this state park are first-come, first-served.

Clover Pass Resort has private RV facilities with hookups. Reservations well in advance are recommended.

Walmart allows free overnight RV parking, limited to one day.

Remote cabin rentals are offered by the U.S. Forest Service and Alaska State Parks. Cabins have bunks, tables and stoves that burn wood or oil. Transport is by charter boat or aircraft.

If you bring a camper, book space early on the Alaska Marine Highway; car decks fill months in advance.



Asian specialties from the Philippines and Japan, including sushi, are served in this historic Pacific Rim port. Mexican and Italian fare is available, as are American-style dining and pizzas.

When you're out, ask for locally roasted coffee and Alaskan beers.

Local businesses present a range of great activities and excursions to make your visit truly unforgettable. Our conveniently located Tour Center operates May through September in the Berth 2 Visitor Information Center. Company representatives help you book dozens of activities, from fishing charters to kayaking, from guided tours to local attractions, and more. All of our operators have state and local licenses and must be insured to operate in Ketchikan. Information to help your contact our Tour Center tenants is on page 13.

Restrooms are provided at both of our Visitor Centers. Taxi stands and public transit are close by each of the facilities.

Natural history, scenic grandeur and plain old fun inspire diverse attractions. Museums, historic sites and interactive tours highlight the long human presence.

Center is a sophisticated federal facility offering interpretive displays on Native culture and on multiple-use management of Tongass National Forest, the nation's largest. Video presentations round out a unique attraction.

Southeast Alaska Discovery

Creek Street borders Ketchikan Creek, where salmon runs attracted Alaska Natives for centuries and salmon still brave the falls in season. Brothels lined the creek from 1903 to 1953.

Shops, restaurants, museums and galleries now welcome visitors to a distinctive neighborhood on the National Register of Historic Places.

Southeast Alaska Discovery Center is an outstanding federal interpretive facility spotlighting the land and the people of Tongass National Forest.


Tongass Historical Museum proudly profies our community's past (and will remain open during improvements to the Centennial Building in 2017). **Dolly's House** down the creek preserves remnants of the red-light district. At **Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show**, athletes show off skills used by


those who work in the woods.

Totem Poles bring global fame to Ketchikan, home of the world's largest collection. Poles stand in numbers in Saxman Native Village south of town, and in Totem Bight State Park and Potlatch Park out north. Poles also stand in many public areas throughout the community. Ancient poles are preserved at Totem Heritage Center, a National Register site.

Intriguing itineraries reward those who bring active interests

Grab maps at our Berth 2 and Berth 3 Visitor Information Centers for two Historic Ketchikan Walking Tours. ATVs offer a splashier excursion.

History highlights

Day 1: Stroll the past on the Historic Ketchikan Walking Tour. Visit Tongass Historical Museum and Dolly's House on the creek. At Totem Heritage Center, comprehend the forms of totemic art.

Day 2: With a foundation in Northwest Coast culture, view totem poles at Saxman

Native Village, Totem Bight State Historical Park and Potlatch Park. Talk to carvers. See Native dancers perform.

Day 3: Learn about Ketchikan industries at Southeast Alaska Discovery Center. Find Fishing History signage. Go to Alaska Rainforest Sanctuary and Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show to see timbering mills and skills.

Something fishy

Day 1: Book a guided half- or full-day salmon fishing charter; have your catch processed and shipped home.

Day 2: Bering Sea Crab Fishermen's tour celebrates commercial fishing in Alaska.

Day 3: Get out in a small open boat, our basic "ride." Guided tours and rentals are available.



Active adventure

Day 1: Paddle and pedal. Kayak and bike tours, and rentals, offer close-up, slow and person-powered adventure.

Day 2: Hike. Trail difficulty varies. Pick up free personal locator beacons and maps from our staff at the Berth 2 Visitor Center.

Day 3: Take the wheel of a Jeep, ATV cart or inflatable boat on a guided tour.

DAYBOOK: MORE CAN'T-MISS ATTRACTIONS

Plan your days around only-in-Ketchikan action



The place we call 'Misty' is not to be missed

Day 1: Fly in a floatplane, cruise in a fast boat, or do a combo tour to world-class Misty Fiords National Monument.

Day 2: Enjoy tremendous wildlife viewing. Bears are seen more often in late summer, birds and marine life year-round.

Day 3: Picnic at the beach. Look for intertidal critters and flotsam treasures and at low tide.



Get your art pumping

Day 1: Check in at the Arts Council and First City Players on Main Street. Visit galleries; Mission Street is essential.

Day 2: Use ketchikanartliveshere.com to pencil a tour of Ketchikan's uniquely diverse public art installations.

Day 3: Use calendars to find live music. Lunch with music at an art café; at night, a restaurant, cabaret or lounge.

The rain forest of the North Pacific generates amazing life, from sky-touching trees to the wildlife that shares our islands

We share our forested lands and the surrounding ocean with an compelling array of wildlife. The temperate rain forest is not only one of the most beautiful places on earth, it's also one of the most biologically productive areas. Use the map in this guide to scope trails that will put you




right in the middle of our unique environment. Make a plan, collect appropriate clothing and gear, and get out there!

- More than 250 species of birds have been identified around the Ketchikan area. The Alaska Hummingbird Festival in April celebrates the springtime return of migratory birds.
- Migrating humpback whales and orcas (a k a killer whales), sea lions, seals and Dall porpoises are often spotted on cruise excursions.
- Sitka black-tailed deer inhabit the beaches and forest. Mountain goats and wolves are sighted at higher elevations.

MISTY FJORDS TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST

Ketchikan is the gateway to spectacular country

Misty Fjords National Monument's deep canals and inlets were carved by glaciers thousands of years ago. Some people call this granite grandeur the Yosemite of the North.

Misty Fjords provides outstanding recreational opportunities and wildlife habitat, accessible by floatplane or boat from Ketchikan. The near edge of the 2.3 million-acre area is only 40 miles south of Ketchikan.


Day cruises and flightseeing trips are offered daily in summer Kayak companies and charter boats offer guided overnight trips.

- U.S. Forest Service maintains wilderness cabins in the monument for visitors who want extended visits.
- Pictographs—ancient Native rock art—are etched into cliff walls in the monument. New Eddystone Rock, a picturesque volcanic core seen on the opposite page, thrusts from an island at the monument entrance.
- Allow four hours for a cruise and two hours for a flightseeing trip.

Ketchikan is in the heart of Tongass National Forest. At 17 million acres, it is the largest national forest in the U.S. You can travel 500 miles from Ketchikan to Yakutat and never leave the national forest. You're visiting the Tongass—whether you know it or not—when you cruise wild shores, hike local trails, fly to a remote lake, or camp and

remote lake, or camp and picnic at a recreation area.

This temperate rain forest is integral to the lifestyle of Southeast Alaska and always has been. Managed for




multiple uses, the vast forest supports habitat for a rich abundance of plants, animals and birds and provides resources for both recreation and industry.

A world-leading center of Native culture awaits you here

The world's largest collection of totem poles is found in Ketchikan and you can meet the artists and teachers whose work keeps the Native culture vital. The heritage of Northwest Coast tribes is integral here: Nearly 20 of every 100 residents of Ketchikan can trace some of their heritage to the Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian tribes of Alaska.

- Totem Bight State Historical Park features a longhouse and an impressive collection of restored totem poles. Interpretive material lines a trail through the park.
- Saxman Native Village and Totem Bight State Historical Park display poles and clan

- houses. The parks also feature performances of Native dancers.
- Artisans at Saxman Native
 Village carving center work on
 contemporary totem poles and
 invite you to get close.
- Tongass Historical Museum displays ancient tools and implements.

Priceless artistry in ancient wood is displayed at the Totem Heritage Center, an essential interpretive destination for visitors. The center is also an educational facility where talented artists and artisans teach design, toolmaking, carving and traditional weaving.




- Potlatch Park presents a replica of a Native village, including totemic carvings. A museum displays classic cars and firearms.
- Totem Heritage Center preserves ancient poles retrieved from abandoned villages. The center also instructs in traditional Northwest Coast design and art.



Delores Churchill's weaving represents a lifetime dedicated to a traditional art; her teaching passes the legacy to new generations. Churchill and Nathan Jackson are recipients of the National Heritage Fellowship Award from the National Endowment for the Arts.

Ketchikan has been recognized as one of America's Top 100 Small Arts Communities for the number of our artists and performers and the vitality of our arts scene. Public art abounds, from Alaska Native carving to commissioned contemporary pieces. See artwork in our galleries and shops. Immerse yourself in festivals, museums and special events. Check in with our Visitor Centers to discover what's happening on our cultural calendar during your visit.

Ray Troll's fish art travels the world in museum exhibitions—and on T-shirts from his gallery. Our pioneering Wearable Art Show is a dazzling sold-out affair. The homegrown musical melodrama Fish Pirate's Daughter each summer features Little Nell and Sweet William Uprightly—and a pre-show crab feast.

- Celebrate internationally known Native artists working in traditional forms from carving to weaving. Contemporary artists produce amazing work in media from acrylic to sculpture, from ceramics to watercolor.
- Browse the community's diverse art galleries, many owned and operated by resident artists.
- Art exhibits, festivals and special events occur throughout the year. The highlight of summer is the Blueberry Arts Festival on the first





- weekend of August, with a dazzling array of artwork and public events. In the winter, residents put on the Jazz and Cabaret Festival and the Wearable Art Show. Our dance school offers seasonal public performances.
- Ketchikan's theater company produces a full season of stage entertainment.
 Concerts featuring our community band and community chorus also keep performing arts at the forefront.



- Our community's artists speak compellingly about this milieu in *Ketchikan: The Artists*, part of an Emmywinning video series; view it at ketchikanstories.com.





Ketchikan is a great destination for hands-on adventures. Local operators offer a wide range of activities. Just bring your sense of adventure: guides and excursion leaders will provide all the training and equipment you'll need.

Human-powered sightseeing includes bike treks as well as guided kayak and canoe excursions—even one with Native language instruction. You can pedal a prop-driven, two-seat catamaran.

A converted Bering Sea crab boat takes visitors to see the thrills and skills of high-seas fishing. Another boat tour visits a remote inlet for sightseeing and crabbing. Amphibious vehicles offer the best of both worlds, touring historic land sites before splashing into the ocean for a harbor cruise.





Prince of Wales Island

The third-largest island in the United States (often called "P.O.W." locally) is home to several thousand residents in communities of 50 to 1,500. The island is a prime destination for sportfishers and has outstanding opportunities for camping, hunting and hiking—linked by the longest road network in Southeast Alaska. Several roads are designated as Alaska Scenic Byways.

Inter-Island Ferry Authority (IFA) provides daily passage between Ketchikan and Hollis on the east side of P.O.W. Local air carriers connect to the island with daily service.

Remarkable totem pole parks stand in Klawock, Hydaburg and Kasaan. During the summer, the U.S. Forest Service conducts guided tours of El Capitan Cave, the largest of 500 on the island. Register online or at ranger districts.

Visitors and residents run 26 miles of scenic roads on Memorial Day weekend in the Prince of Wales Island Marathon, a sanctioned race that also features half-marathon and relay competitions. By the Sea Arts and Seafood Fest in Coffman Cove the second weekend in August is a highlight of summer for residents and visitors.


