UNESCO Splendors of Peru: Lima, Cuzco & Machu Picchu

8-DAY PRE- OR 7-DAY POST-CRUISE JOURNEY

Experience the colonial splendors of Peru's capital, Cuzco's baroque churches built on Inca temple foundations, and ride the Hiram Bingham Train to the spectacular Inca mountain citadel of Machu Picchu perched high atop an Andean peak.

DAY ONE Upon arrival at Lima International Airport, transfer to Peru's capital city and check in to the Belmond Miraflores Park Hotel, where you will enjoy the evening at leisure.

DAY TWO After breakfast, see the historic highlights of Lima including Lima Cathedral and Santo Domingo Monastery. Visit Casa Aliaga & Casa Luna mansions, private lunch at Casa Luna.

DAY FOUR After breakfast, go to a Quechua-speaking rural village to see the families' wood-fired kitchens, hand-weaving and farming techniques, and take part in a traditional blessing of fields and animals. Spend the evening at leisure.

Hotel: Tambo del Inka, A Luxury Collection

DAY FIVE Visit the Inca Fortress at Ollantaytambo, then take the Hiram Bingham Train between snowcapped peaks to Machu Picchu, for a walking tour of the site interpreted by an expert archaeologist guide.

Hotel: Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo

DAY SIX After breakfast, enjoy a morning guided tour of Machu Picchu, then experience Machu Picchu at your leisure before boarding the train for another thrilling rail trip down the valley to Cuzco.

MACHU PICCHU, PERU



UNESCO Cambodia: Phnom Penh & The Temples of Angkor

6-DAY PRE- OR POST-CRUISE JOURNEY

Experience Cambodia's ancient and modern history in Phnom Penh, and explore the sprawling ruins of the ancient capital of Angkor, once one of the world's largest cities, lost for centuries in the jungle.

DAY ONE Arrive at Phnom Penh and transfer to the Raffles Le Royal Hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is at leisure, dinner is served at the hotel.

DAY TWO See the Royal Palace's Silver Pagoda, ancient Khmer art at the National Museum, and the infamous Khmer Rouge sites. Shop for traditional Cambodian arts and crafts at the Russian Market.

DAY THREE Fly to Siem Reap and visit the 10th-century Banteay Srey Hindu temple, believed to have been carved by women. Then visit the AKP Clean Water Project providing local communities with sanitary water.

DAY FOUR View Angkor Wat at sunrise and the entire complex from the air by helicopter. Explore the sprawling ruins of Angkor Thom, including Bayon Temple and famous Ta Prohm Temple wrapped by large fig trees.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Hotel: Raffles Siem Reap

DAY FIVE Visit three temples in Angkor Thom and the brick Rolous Khmer temples. Meet a local chef to shop in the open market and enjoy a Khmer cooking class.

DAY SIX After breakfast, check out of your hotel and transfer to Siem Reap airport for your flight to Singapore.


One of Japan's best-preserved cities, Kanazawa escaped war damage and natural disasters to reward visitors with a wealth of architecture as an important clan castle town from the mid-17th century until the middle of the 19th. The mighty Kanazawa Castle did not survive intact, but its famous Ishikawa Gate, the Sunjikken Longhouse and lavish Kenrokuen Garden hint at the grandeur. Of special note are the surviving Higashi Geisha District and Samurai District streets. The Temple area holds the Myoryuji Temple with its hidden passages and secret doors giving it the nickname the Ninja Temple. The Oyamajinja Shrine is a later addition, its three-story gate with impressive stained glass windows reveal a Dutch influence.

Please note that the contract includes a clause specifying that subject to specific exceptions, disputes will be arbitrated before the American Arbitration Association in King County, State of Washington. Disputes not subject to arbitration shall be subject to certain courts in the State of Washington as the exclusive forum for resolving disputes. Seabourn shall have the right to cancel or alter in any way any scheduled sailing or itinerary which, in its sole judgment and discretion, is justified for any reason and to do so without liability for damage or for any loss to guests. Seabourn also reserves the right, in the event of a full-ship charter or for any other reason, to cancel reservations whether or not a deposit or full payment has been received. In such an event, Seabourn's only liability will be to refund to guests the amount it has received.

You shall be responsible for complying with the requirements of all immigration, port, health, customs, and police authorities, and all other laws and regulations of each country or state from or to which you will travel. You must at all times obey all the rules, regulations and orders of the ship, Carrier and the Captain.

Situations may arise which, in our discretion, make it necessary for us for any reason, without prior notice, to cancel, advance or postpone a scheduled departure, change itineraries or make substitutions involving hotels, restaurants, ports of call, other travel components, vessels or other modes of transportation, comply with all governmental laws and orders given by governmental authorities, or render assistance to preserve life

and property. The Master of the ship as well as the operator of any other means of transportation may, in his/her sole discretion, take any action deemed necessary for the safety, security, comfort or well-being of any person or to prevent damage to or loss of the ship. DEPOSIT

A 25% deposit is required within three days of reservation or sooner for cruises of 14 days or less, or within 7 days or sooner for cruises of 15 days or more, as specified by Seabourn.

BALANCE OF PAYMENT

All cruises of 25 days or less: Seabourn must receive full payment 90 days before sailing. All reservations are subject to cancellation without notice if payments are not received by the due date, and are finalized only when paid in full at 90 days prior to sailing. Reservations made within 90 days require full payment within one day of the reservation or sooner, as specified by Seabourn.

All cruises of 26 days or longer: Seabourn must receive full payment 120 days before sailing: All reservations are subject to cancellation without notice if payments are not received by the due date, and are finalized only when paid in full at 120 days prior to sailing. Reservations made within 120 days require full payment within one day of the reservation or sooner, as specified by Seabourn.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

Only U.S. dollar payments are accepted. Seabourn accepts payments via agency check, personal check, American Express®, Visa®, MasterCard®, Diner's Club®, DiscoverCard® or JCB® card. Expenses incurred for on board services and products by the guest, or by Seabourn on behalf of the guest, shall be paid by the guest prior to disembarkation. Personal checks or letters of credit cannot be honored for onboard accounts.

TAXES, FEES & PORT EXPENSES

"Taxes, Fees & Port Expenses," as used by us, may include any and all fees, charges, tolls and taxes imposed on us by governmental or quasi-governmental authorities, as well as third party fees and charges arising from a vessel's presence in a harbor or port. Taxes, Fees & Port Expenses may include U.S. Customs fees, head taxes, Panama Canal tolls, dockage fees, wharfage fees, inspection fees, pilotage, air taxes, hotel or VAT taxes incurred as part of a land tour, immigration and naturalization fees, and Internal Revenue Service fees, as well as fees paid to third parties for navigation, berthing, stevedoring, baggage handling/storage and security services. Taxes, Fees & Port Expenses may be assessed per passenger, per berth, per ton or per vessel. Assessments calculated on a per ton or per



vessel basis will be spread over the number of passengers on the Ship. Taxes, Fees & Port Expenses are subject to change and we reserve the right to collect any increases in effect at the time of sailing even if the fare has already been paid in full.

CANCELLATION FEES

Given that the resale of cancelled space will likely result in a lost opportunity to sell other space, these fees are due regardless of resale. You hereby agree that losses sustained by us in the event of your cancellation would be very difficult or impossible to quantify, and that the fees set forth in our cancellation policy represent a fair and reasonable assessment as liquidated damages. Fees incurred as a result of cancellation cannot be applied to future bookings. Refunds will normally be made to your travel professional. Travel professionals may impose their own cancellation fees. Agency fees of any nature are a matter to be decided on solely by the agency and guests.

Travel agencies provide valuable service and counseling to prospective travelers. We encourage you to make your Seabourn reservations with a travel professional. You acknowledge that your travel agent acts solely as your agent, and not as agent for Carrier, and is deemed as your agent. Further, receipt by your travel agent of the Cruise Contract or any other communications, notices or information from Carrier shall constitute receipt of such materials by you. Travel agencies are not owned or controlled by Seabourn.

The above cancellation fees apply when either the entire booking, or any portion of a booking is cancelled or transferred to an alternative sailing, and shall apply to all travel including cruise, airfare and land arrangements. If only non-cruise components are cancelled, the guest will be responsible for any cancellation fees imposed by the airlines, other transportation carriers, tour and ground operators or hotel properties. CANCELLATION POLICY EXCEPTION

If you have purchased a specially priced promotion that is 100% non-refundable from the point of payment, you are not entitled to any refund, payment, compensation or credit whatsoever of your gross fare if you cancel your booking.

LIMITATIONS ON CARRIER'S LIABILITY

Under no circumstances shall the Carrier be or become liable for consequential or other damages of any kind sustained by any Guests except as expressly provided in the Cruise Contract.

PERSONAL DATA

In order to process your booking and to ensure that your travel arrangements run smoothly and meet your requirements, Seabourn needs to use the personal and sensitive data you provide such as name, address, any special needs, health, medical, mobility or dietary requirements, etc. In accordance with its privacy policies, Seabourn may share your personal and sensitive data to third parties such as travel agents, airlines, hotels and transport companies, or as required by law. This may involve sending your personal data between different countries, including countries outside the European Union (EU) where controls on data protection may not be as strong as the legal requirements in this country.

NOTICE CONCERNING SAFETY AND SECURITY

Carrier visits a large number of ports in numerous countries around the world. At any given moment there are likely to be "trouble spots" in the world in terms of war, terrorism, crime, Act of God, civil commotions, labor trouble, and/or other potential sources of harm. Local conditions and infrastructure may also create hazards to Guest while off the ship. Accordingly, it may be necessary to change, cancel or terminate the scheduled cruise or any activities related to the cruise, including without limitation shore excursions and port visits. Although Carrier endeavors to provide reasonable protection for your comfort and safety on board its ships, Carrier cannot guarantee freedom from all risks associated with war, terrorism, crime or other potential sources of harm. Carrier reminds all Guests that they must ultimately assume responsibility for their actions while ashore. The United States Department of State and other similar government agencies regularly issue advisories and warnings to travelers giving details of local conditions in specified cities and countries according to such agency's perception of risks to travelers. Although unlikely, the ship may be confronted by actual or threatened war, warlike operations or hostilities. Carrier has the absolute right and sole discretion to respond to safety concerns of any kind, including but not limited to sailing with or without lights, deviating from customary practices or rules and regulations concerning navigation, cargo or other matters in time of peace, or sailing armed or unarmed and with or without convoy.

There are risks inherent to being aboard the ship. These include, by way of example, having to evacuate the ship or other means of transportation in case of emergency, having to move about on the ship or other vessels during rough seas and lack of access to full medical services. For people who are ill or who have a mental or physical disability or impairment, these risks are more significant. For example: access to all parts of the ship,

other means of transportation or to facilities on shore may be difficult or impossible for some guests. In addition, medical evacuations during the Cruise, whether by sea, by tender, or by deviating from the scheduled itinerary, may create an increased risk of harm and may not be feasible for a variety of reasons. We reserve the right to determine, in our sole discretion exercised in good faith, whether and when a medical evacuation from the ship will occur.

OPTIONAL TRAVEL PROTECTION

We strongly recommend that all guests purchase some form of Trip Cancellation/Interruption Protection to help protect your vacation investment. REFUNDS

Partial use of cruise, airfare, hotel and land extensions does not qualify a guest for a refund. All refund requests pertaining to cruise, land and air are subject to final review by Seabourn.

EXTENDED HOTEL STAYS

Fares are per person double occupancy and include daily breakfast, private car transfers, a hospitality representative, portage and bell service gratuities throughout, and all taxes. Seabourn reserves the right to substitute hotels of similar quality. Not all hotels can accommodate triples and quads, and when available may consist of two double beds which may not be suitable for three adults. If you require separate beds, we suggest that you pre-purchase an additional room before the start of your cruise. Special requests such as smoking, king or double beds, etc., are at the discretion of the hotel and cannot be guaranteed. Guests are responsible for incidentals and meals unless noted otherwise. Guests whose Seabourn air arrangements require a hotel "forced overnight" may be accommodated in a property of a different standard than typically used for Seabourn luxury hotel packages

BAGGAGE/ VALUABLES/PROHIBITED ITEMS

Each fully paid adult guest will be allowed a reasonable amount of luggage on board containing their personal belongings. Please remember to check with your airline on their baggage restrictions and limitations. Guests are solely responsible for any baggage fees charged by the airline(s) at time of check-in. Seabourn's responsibility for lost, damaged or misplaced baggage and other personal property is limited by the Cruise Contract. Seabourn is not responsible for camera equipment, jewelry, cash, medications, medical devices, dental appliances, or other similarly fragile and valuable items contained in checked or unchecked baggage, left in the suite or in public areas onboard. These items should be personally carried by guests and placed in the suite safe once onboard. Please review the Cruise Contract terms and conditions for additional information. For your safety, all baggage must pass a security checkpoint.

You may not take on board firearms, controlled or prohibited substances, inflammable or hazardous items, and other items prohibited by applicable law, or any other items prohibited by applicable law, or any other item

Carrier deems in its sole discretion to be detrimental to the safety, security, comfort or well-being of any person.

CHILDREN TRAVELING WITH AN ADULT

Please note that some countries have special requirements for minors (under age 18) who are not traveling with both parents. Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and if that adult is not a parent or legal guardian, written permission from the parent or legal guardian is required. Please discuss this with your travel professional.

MEDICAL SERVICES

Each of our ships is equipped with limited medical facilities that are staffed by a physician and registered nurses. The physician is an independent contractor. There will be a fee charged for all medical services and medications obtained on board. If you become ill during the cruise and the physician is unable to care for your needs on board, you will be transferred to medical facilities on shore. If your condition will require that you have special medical apparatus or assistance on board, we must be made aware of that at time of booking in order to determine whether we can accommodate your needs. If you are using prescription drugs, please bring an adequate supply with you and keep them in your carry-on luggage

MINORS AS GUESTS/PREGNANCY POLICY

Guests under 21 years of age must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or chaperone who is at least 21 years old; one adult chaperone is required for every five people under age 21. We will not accept reservations for infants 6 months or younger for non-transocean sailings, 12 months or younger for transocean sailings at the time the cruise commences. Seabourn cannot accept a booking or carry any guest who will be 24 completed weeks or more pregnant on the last day of the intended cruise. All pregnant women are required to produce a physician's letter stating that mother and baby are in good health, fit to travel, and that the pregnancy is not high-risk.

ALCOHOL, GAMBLING, SMOKING

We are committed to the responsible service of alcohol. There may be times when we consider it appropriate to refuse the service of alcohol to a guest for any reason. Guests must be 21 years or over to purchase or consume alcohol on board. For voyages that depart from and return to Australia, New Zealand, Europe, China, Hong Kong, Singapore or Taiwan, this policy applies to guests 18 years and older. For voyages which depart from and return to Japan, this policy applies to guests 20 years and older. Any alcohol purchased ashore will be collected at the gangway for safe keeping and will be returned to you on the last day of your cruise.

No Guest under the age of 18 shall be permitted to engage in any gaming activities on board any ship or to purchase cigarettes or tobacco products.

For the comfort of all of our guests all staterooms including stateroom verandas, showrooms and most other indoor areas are designated non-smoking.



EMBARKATION/DISEMBARKATION

The ship generally will be available for embarkation two hours before the scheduled sailing time noted on the itinerary sent with the final documents. You are responsible for arriving at the respective port on time for embarkation and for joining the vessel at its next port of call if, for any reason, you miss a scheduled sailing. Seabourn reserves the right to refuse or discontinue passage to anyone when, in Seabourn's judgment, it would be considered a risk to the guest's own safety and well-being or the health, safety, well-being, comfort and enjoyment of any other guest or crew member. On disembarkation day, suites must be vacated two hours after the scheduled arrival time, unless otherwise approved by the Hotel Director. Guests making their own air arrangements should allow 3 to 4 hours for transfer time to the airport once customs and immigration clearance has been completed.

GUESTS WITH DISABILITIES

We do not discriminate against persons on the basis of disability. We seek, to the extent feasible, to accommodate the needs of persons with disabilities. Guests with disabilities are welcome aboard Seabourn ships. Guests who have medical, physical or other special requirements must advise Seabourn's Reservation Department at time of reservation. Upon notification by a guest with a disability, Seabourn Reservations can assist in providing any relevant information pertaining to accessibility onboard the vessels. We have a limited number of suites designated for wheelchair access. Due to the configuration of our ships, individuals using a wheelchair and individuals with vision loss may experience some difficulties in accessing certain areas. For safety reasons, guests in wheelchairs cannot be carried up staircases or gangways, nor on launches when the ship is at anchor. Seabourn is pleased to permit individuals to bring qualified service animals on board. Notice that a guest will be traveling with an animal must be provided at the time of booking. Local laws or customs may prevent animals from disembarking at particular ports and countries. It is the guest's obligation to obtain all documents/health certificates that may be required. Consult local customs authorities for information and requirements.

In limited situations where an individual with a disability would be unable to satisfy certain specified safety and other criteria, even when provided with appropriate auxiliary aids and services, we may find it necessary to ask the individual to make alternative travel arrangements.

Guests with conditions requiring ongoing medical assistance may be asked to have their physician provide a confidential certification form to ensure that they may travel safely. SPECIAL DIETS

Guests with special dietary needs should notify Seabourn at the time of booking or at the latest, six weeks before sailing. Every effort will be made to comply with these requests.

Transfer and package cancellations follow cruise cancellation policy. All custom package changes or cancellations are 100% non-refundable.

OPTIONAL SHORE EXCURSIONS

Shore excursions purchased on board or via our website, Seabourn.com, are subject to a 100% cancellation fee if cancelled after the published closing date, for the port in question. Cancellations of shore excursions made more than three days prior to embarkation will be fully refunded; cancellations made on board or within the three-day window prior to embarkation may be subject a cancellation fee. Cancellation fees for certain shore excursions may be up to 100% of the shore excursion price, depending on the shore excursion. For on board cancellations of shore excursions, please speak with the Shore Excursion department on board for the actual cancellation fee amount. Shore excursions are "Non-Provider Services" for the purposes of your Cruise Contract. All cancellations made on board will be refunded in the form of onboard credit, regardless of whether the purchase was made by a guest or a third party.

Shore excursions are subject to change or cancellation without prior warning, based on local conditions at the time of ship's arrival.

All guests must carry their valid passport. We strongly recommend carrying a passport that is valid for at least six months beyond the completion date of your travel, as this is required by some countries. In addition, certain countries may require entry visas. You are responsible for securing proper documentation for the countries visited on your cruise and overland tour destinations.

Boarding may be denied or fines may be levied against those guests without proper documentation. Payment of any fines levied is the responsibility of the individual guest. Consult your travel advisor for advice on such requirements. Visa requirements vary by destination country and are subject to change by governments without notice. During a voyage, circumstances may require that Seabourn obtain a group entry visa for all guests, the cost of which will be charged to the guests' onboard account. You will be provided with preliminary cruise documents approximately three months prior to departure. These will contain instructions for viewing visa information from an independent visa service online, should you wish to avail yourself of this service.

Vaccination/immunization requirements vary considerably depending on the area of the world visited, and are subject to change at any time. We strongly recommend that all guests contact their personal physician, the Department of Public Health or the Centers for Disease Control for specific recommendations and/or requirements.
